

**Meeting of St Davids Peninsula Community Land Trust Directors**  
**St Davids Rugby Club on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at 7.30pm**

1. **Apologies** received from: Vicky Barker, Tracy Lindsey, Jill Morgan and Brigit Thurstan.
2. **Minutes of previous meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2018.**  
Minutes approved.
3. **Matters arising from previous meeting minutes.**  
Letters to PCNPA and Landowner. These have been sent and acknowledged.  
Letter received from Members. The matter has been resolved. An apology has been received and accepted.
4. **Update on the current position regarding Plans and Planning Applications.**  
The Glasfryn Road planning application will be considered at the meeting of the planning committee to be held on 6<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at 10.00am. This may be held in St Davids. The meeting will be open to the public, although it is not a public meeting, the community will be able to witness the proceedings. 5. **Alternative sites on the peninsula.** Candidate sites for the Development Plan can be put forward until 01.06.18. A form is available on the National Park website.  
Andy Middleton reminded the meeting about a housing project in Bristol. He will circulate details.
6. **St Davids Awareness day**  
Andy Dixon reported that it had not been possible to get responses to the questionnaire as the Community Forum also had a questionnaire. Most visitors to the stand were already aware of the activities of the CLT although people were pleased that the swimming pool was still on the agenda. Those interested in the housing were referred to Pembrokeshire Housing.
7. **Vision development**  
Draft prepared by Andy Middleton and published on the website.  
Discussion focused on the definition of 'need' for housing. Andy Middleton will amend and publish on the website.
8. **Action plan for the future.** The Business Plan for the proposed swimming pool needs to be updated. Money available to St Davids (and possibly the other community councils) from the second home surcharge could be used for this. Bill Preece will pursue this. Leisure Republic prepared the last one and could be asked to contribute to an update, as well as Keith Ashton (a colleague of Andy Middleton) and Sue Rees (Narbeth swimming pool) and Cris Tomos.
9. **Any Other Business**  
Andy Dixon raised the issue of the change in the law regarding data protection.  
There is no need to contact all members but we should have a policy statement regarding data protection.
